We wondered could we really transition from a charitable mindset of givers and receivers to one where everyone had something of value to bring to the table?

We saw parents who entered hesitant leaving with huge smiles and arms full of toys they had purchased for their children. We saw volunteers and parents connecting not as giver and receiver, but as neighbors. We saw that this crazy idea had worked! We are endlessly grateful to the donors, volunteers, partners and families that supported us that first year.

Since that initial event we have expanded our reach, refined our processes and adapted our format to the challenges of a global pandemic. This year we want to once again come alongside our neighbors and enable them to provide the magic of Christmas to their families. We hope you will join us!

Our Story
The Shafter Christmas

The Shafter Christmas Store came about, as many things do in small towns like Shafter, with a group of friends who saw a problem and got together to see how they could help.

In the Summer of 2017, Brittney reached out to friends Katie and Melissa to get advice on improving the Christmas giving program she led.

Melissa and Katie suggested trying a new model of giving based on a dignity based giving model outlined in Bob Lupton's book Compassion, Justice and the Christian Life.

Dignity based giving recognizes that both donors and recipients want to bring something to the table and that desire should be honored. Though their resources may be limited, parents would rather know that they are providing for their children rather than being given a handout.

And so the Shafter Christmas Store was born....

The Christmas Store partners with Shafter Healthy Start to select families that are invited to the store. Throughout the Fall months community members, service groups, churches and businesses work together with the Shafter Christmas store team to collect brand new toys that are then offered to parents at a one-day shopping event in December at an 80-90% discount.

The Shafter Christmas Store is a special time where the community comes together, not as givers and receivers, but as parents, grandparents, friends, and neighbors celebrating and recognizing each other's worth. We hope you will join with us!

Our Impact

The Shafter Christmas Store launced in 2017 and over the past four years has helped hundreds of childrens in dozens of families. We are very proud of these numbers, but we are prouder still of the stories we hear from parents and volunteers about how this program impacted their lives.

One mother told volunteers how she had left her Christmas decorations in boxes that year because she didn't want to draw attention to the lack of gifts. After realizing she would be able to afford gifts for her children through the Christmas Store, she was excited to return home, put up the tree, and really begin to celebrate the season.

We are also extremely proud of the number of volunteers who return year after year to participate in the Christmas Store. 90% of our volunteers continue to participate after their first year.



Since 2017, the Shafter Christmas Store has served 129 familes with 543 children.



Over the past 4 years, 300+ volunteers have participated in the Shafter Christmas Store.



Apporximately 2,100 toys have been donated and distrubted to families.



On average, parents spent \$7.27 per child. They received 3 toys per child, with an approximate retail value of \$60. An 80% discount!
